RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

June 7, 1977

On motion of Supervisor Riley, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the County Superintendent of Schools and the County Board of Education have proposed that all duties and functions of an educational nature performed by the Board of Supervisors be transferred to the County Board of Education, and

WHEREAS, such a transfer of duties and functions will better serve the citizens of Orange County and those local agencies providing for their educational needs, and

WHEREAS, a transfer of educational duties and functions to the County Board of Education will permit the elimination of certain inequities in benefits currently existing among employees within the office of the County Superintendent of Schools, and

WHEREAS, the proposal includes the establishment of a single County School Service Fund Budget for the County Board of Education, County Superintendent of Schools and County Committee on School District Organization, and provide for the levy of a separate tax rate for such budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

I. TRANSFER OF EDUCATIONAL DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. Pursuant to Article 3 (commencing at Section 1080), Chapter 1, Part 2, of the Education Code, this Board hereby transfers all of the following duties Resolution No. 77-933 Transfer of Duties & Functions to the Or. Co. Bd. of Education

1 and functions to the County Board of Education:

2 A. Approval of the County Superintendent of Schools' esti-  
3 mated revenue and expenditures pursuant to the provisions of Section  
4 1042 of the Education Code following which it shall be filed with the  
5 County Board of Supervisors and the County Auditor-Controller.

6 B. The allowance of the actual and necessary travel expenses,  
7 the expenses of the Office of the County Superintendent of Schools,  
8 and the expenses of providing housing for all of the services of the  
9 County Superintendent of Schools, pursuant to Sections 1200, 1201, 1202,  
10 and 1203 of the Education Code.

11 C. In addition to the functions specified in Section 1043  
12 of the Education Code, all duties and functions relative to the organiza-  
13 tion or reorganization of school districts and community college distric

14 D. Such other duties and functions of an educational nature  
15 as hereinafter may be specified in this Resolution or set forth in an  
16 agreement entered into between this Board and the County Board of  
17 Education.

18 II. SINGLE COUNTY SCHOOL SERVICE FUND BUDGET. The provisions of  
19 Article 2 (commencing with Sections 1620), Chapter 5, Part 2, of the  
20 Education Code which establishes a single county school service fund  
21 budget is hereby made applicable in Orange County. On and after the  
22 effective date of this Resolution, all expenses of the County Board of  
23 Education, the County Committee on School District Organization and  
24 the County Superintendent of Schools required or authorized to be paid  
25 from the County General Fund, pursuant to Education Code Section 1510  
26 or any other provision of law, shall no longer be payable from the  
27 County General Fund but shall be payable solely from the single County  
28 School Service Fund and provided for in the single budget made

1 applicable by this Resolution.

2 III. TERMINATION OF COUNTY EMPLOYMENT. The provisions of Article 4  
3 (commencing with Section 1310), Chapter 2, Part 2, of the Education Code,  
4 which terminates County employment for certain County employees within  
5 the office of the County Superintendent of Schools and who thereby become  
6 employees of the County Superintendent of Schools are hereby made opera-  
7 tive in Orange County. The terms and conditions of employment for such  
8 employees affected by this Resolution shall be those specified in said  
9 Article 4 of the Education Code, and as may be specified by agreement  
10 between this Board and the County Board of Education.

11 IV. COUNTY GOVERNMENT SERVICES.

12 A. This Board shall continue to provide at no charge to the  
13 County Board of Education, the County Superintendent of Schools and the  
14 County Committee on School District Organization, those services of County  
15 government which are by law required to be provided to such entities.  
16 The cost of such services shall not be used in the computation of the  
17 tax rate authorized for the County Superintendent of Schools.

18 B. County government services, other than those required to  
19 be provided by law, shall be made available upon request to the County  
20 Board of Education, the County Superintendent of Schools and the County  
21 Committee on School District Organization; provided, however, that the  
22 cost of such services shall be paid for by the County School Service  
23 Fund. The amount of such costs and the manner of payment shall be as  
24 agreed upon between this Board and the County Board of Education.

25 C. Nothing in this Resolution or any agreements entered into  
26 to implement this Resolution shall be construed as discouraging coopera-  
27 tion, coordination, or communication between agencies and departments  
28 of County government and the County Board of Education, the County

1 Superintendent of Schools, and the County Committee on School District  
2 Organization.

3 V. TRANSFER OF TITLE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY. Title to personal  
4 property as shall be specified by agreement between this Board and the  
5 County Board of Education which is assigned to or being used by the  
6 County Board of Education, the County Superintendent of Schools, and the  
7 County Committee on School District Organization, shall vest in the  
8 office of the County Superintendent of Schools on the effective date of  
9 this Resolution.

10 VI. COMPUTATION OF MAXIMUM TAX RATES. Maximum tax rates for the  
11 office of the County Superintendent of Schools shall be computed pursuant  
12 to Sections 2500 through 2508 of the Education Code. Tax rates levied on  
13 behalf of the County Superintendent of Schools are to be individually stated  
14 on the tax bills or included within a total County educational tax rate.

15 VII. IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS RESOLUTION. For purposes of implement-  
16 ing the provisions of this Resolution, agreements between this Board and  
17 the County Board of Education, or the County Superintendent of Schools  
18 may be entered into in order to more thoroughly accomplish the purposes  
19 of the transfer of educational duties and functions.

20 VIII. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution and any implementing agree-  
21 ments shall be effective at 11:59 p.m., June 30, 1977, unless a different  
22 effective date is provided for in any particular agreement; provided,  
23 however, that this Resolution shall be of no force and effect unless and  
24 until the County Board of Education, by Resolution, accepts this transfer  
25 of educational duties and functions, upon the terms and conditions set  
26 forth herein.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of this Board is directed  
28 to execute the Agreement for the transfer of educational duties and

1 functions from the Board of Supervisors to the County Board of Education  
2 which was attached as Exhibit 2 to the letter dated May 31, 1977, from  
3 the County Superintendent of Schools, the Administrative Officer, and  
4 the County Auditor-Controller to the Board of Supervisors.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that certain Memorandum of Understandin  
6 between the County of Orange and the Orange County Employees Associatio  
7 dated May 18, 1977, concerning the rights of employees affected by the  
8 transfer of educational duties and functions to the Board of Education  
9 from the Board of Supervisors is hereby approved and adopted.


