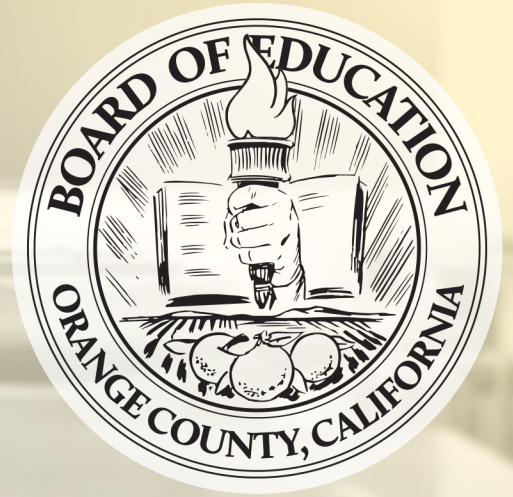


Savvy Safety in Public Schools — Forum —
